

Homework Rules

On any particular exam date **homework problems** may be collected in *addition to or in place of* exam questions.

1 Format, written or typed portions, and code and numerical output.

- Each problem is to be presented on a sheet of E2 or $8\frac{1}{2} \times 11$ blank paper.
- Write on one-side only (thus it is strongly encouraged that you use paper that's already been used once, reuse yeah!).
- At the top of each sheet should be
 - your name on the left,
 - the course name, assignment number, and due date in the middle,
 - the problem number on the right.

2 Grading.

- On each due date, only a subset of the assigned problems will be collected, **thus do not staple your assignments.**
- In this course we begin to work more like mathematicians, **thus presentation counts.**

3 Ethics

- It is O.K. to discuss problems with others.
- Is **absolutely not** O.K. to turn in copied work. This is grounds for failure in the course and disciplinary action by the university.
